Policy on Program Outcomes and Course Outcomes and Attainment

The process of attainment of COs and POs starts with finalizing COs for each course of the program from the first year to the final year. The faculty in charge of respective Programs (B.A, B.Sc.(Home Science), and BFD) have written down the program outcomes. Program-specific outcomes and course outcomes from all courses (subject) were collected from all teachers of respective subjects. The outcomes of different programs are monitored and updated if required. The course outcomes are also told to students. Program outcomes (PO) and course outcomes (CO) have been written and defined by every department for the respective courses and, discussed by faculties with the students during the teaching-learning process and are also displayed on the college website. The college has developed a system for the evaluation of attainment outcomes.

Method of assessment of course outcomes

Both direct and indirect assessments should be taken into consideration for the attainment CO.

- **Direct attainment:-**

- Students Projects
- Students Assignments
- Open book
- Unit test
- Midterm (Test exam)
- Attainment with the help of internal and external evaluation.

- **Indirect attainment:-**

- Innovative and creative methods of teaching-learning and evaluation like small group discussion, role play, and seminars to measure the attainment of communicative language skills.
- Peer teaching to check the attainment of subject knowledge and stage daring.
- Giving exercise in the classroom and at home
- Practical work
- Field visits and survey
- Percentage of attendance
