

Policy Document for availing Scholarship and Freeship

S. S. Girls' College Gondia is affiliated to R.T.M. Nagpur University Nagpur and is recognized under section 2(f) of UGC Act 1956. We follow all the state /central and university norms for offering scholarship and freeship to all the admitted students for all the programs. The institution publishes its updated prospectus which highlights the various scholarship schemes available for the students for all the categories.

Guidelines for the Scholarship and Freeship

- 1) The college provides all the necessary information about the scholarship at the beginning of academic year.
- 2) The college notifies the list of Government/Non-government scholarship. All the notifications / circulars / brochures regarding scholarship display by administrative section.
 - 3) The College office addresses all the queries and guides the students time to time.
- 4) The college is registered on the state Government Scholarship portal, which is easily accessible for the students to apply for the same.
 - 5) The college office processes of verification, e-verification as per the procedure.
- 6) It shall be the duty of students to register on Scholarship portal as per the eligibility criterion.
- 7) The college office is committed to keep the students informed and provide necessary assistance.
- 8) Any request for attestation, Bonafede certificate are addressed immediately by college office staff.
 - 9. The college office processes all the application on time.
- 10) The college office informs to the students about Renewal application alerts and it is also circulated through the notices as well as displayed on the Notice Board.
- 11) It shall be duty of college office to provide Contact number of scholarship section to students, if required.
 - 12) The students are informed about Online scholarship links.

Scholarship, Freeshipand Concessions Schemes

1. Scholarship and Freeship

- a. GOI Scholarship (income below Rs. 2, 50000/ for SC/ST students and RS. 1, 00000 /for NT/VJ/SBC/OBC students.
- b. Open Merit Scholarship.
- c. National Loan Scholarship.
- d. Political sufferer scholarship (ff)
- e. Orthopedically handicapped Scholarship
- f. Bidi Worker's Children's Scholarship.
- g. Minority Communities Scholarship(Muslim, Parsi, Sikh, Christian, Buddhist)

Above 50% Marks ii) Annual Income below-1,00000.

2. Concessions

- a. EBC(Income less than 1,00000)
- b. PTC/STC
- c. OBC/SBC/NT/VJNT,income limit 6.50.000lakh More than this limits the candidate comes under free ship.

Note-Non eligibility of students for freeship and GOI Scholarship

- a. Re-admitted students are not eligible
- b. D. Ed students are not eligible
- c. Only SC/ST Students are applicable under BFD, Graduation Course.
- d. B.Ed. students are not eligible for GOI in PG courses.

Procedure:

- The students are given information about various Scholarship/free ship,portal and links
- The students are told to have their bank account get the Aadhar seeded to it.
- Submission of all necessary particulars such as income certificate, information about DBT is provided as almost all the govt. scholarships are disbursed to the bank account of the beneficiary.
- The students are advised to visit the portal and complete the registration.
- They are advised to keep the following details or documents ready.
 - i. e-mail ID
 - ii. Mobile no.
 - iii. Bank Account number with IFSC code
 - iv. Bonafide certificate
 - v. Income certificate
 - vi. Caste certificate

- vii. Scanned copy of the first page of Bank Account
- viii. Any other specified document
