I request you to pay regular attention to the studies, attendance and behaviour of your ward and make it a point to visit the College in due intervals.


Principal S.S..Girls'College,Gondia

II CONTINUOUS INTERNAL EVALUATION SYSTEM

There shall be **Unit Tests** of every subject in the month of **August & February.** There shall be Bi-annual Test Exam. of 3 Hrs. duration in the moth of October & March.

Note: I) Exams are compulsory for all the students. ii) Those remaining absent will be fined `50/- per test/paper. iii) Leaving the answer sheet blank in not allowed.

"PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND RECREATION"

- 1. Abstract from ordinance No. 9: Under this ordinance of the University, all the undergraduate students of College shall be required to participate in Physical Training.
- 2. a) All undergraduate students in the college affiliated to Nagpur University who opt for Physical Training shall attend Physical Education Classes, 3 periods in a week with a minimum of 60 periods in a session. Failure to attend the classes will be fined at the rate of Rs.1/- per class.
 - b) Each physical Training period will be of 30 minutes duration for Physical Exercises and recreation activities.
 - c) The Board of Physical Education and Recreation may prescribe uniforms.
- 3. The students must attend at least 80 percent of the Physical Training periods actually held in a session.
- 4. The following classes of students shall be exempted from the operation of this ordinance:
 - i) Students having completed the age of 26 at the time of admission to the college.

75% attendance is necessary for appearing University Examination. The absentee will be charges `2/- per period. On producing guardian's letter with proof, the case may be considered by the Principal/Attendance Committee.

ELECTION

ATTENDANCE

As per the rules and regulation of the R.T.M. Nagpur University, Nagpur, the election for students representative council will be held.

EXCURSIONS

Only Educational Excursions are arranged. Not pleasure trips are allowed.

- ii) Students found unfit on medical ground if recommended by the Medical Officer of the college and Principal with detailed reasons for unfitness. iii) Students in the fined year.
- iv) Students who have participated in : a) Inter Collegiate, b) Inter University or c) State Level Tournaments.
- v) Students attending Social Service Camp arranged or approved by the college.
- vi) Students who have attended college gymnastics and outdoor sports.
- 5. A students who is eligible for examination under clause 4 above shall obtain an Exemption Certificate in the prescribed form from the Principal before 1st December every year and shall attache the same to her application for admission to the examination. No case of exemption shall be considered unless Exemption Certificate is attached by the student to her application form for admission to the examination.
- 6. If a student fails to present herself at the Physical Efficiency Test without Test without sufficient cause, she shall pay a fine of ₹10/- or more as: decided by the college.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Every Student of the college shall present herself for Medical Examination before the Medical Officer of the College on such date or dates as may be fixed by the Medical Officer in consultation with the Principal.

A student who remains absent from Medical Examination at the appointed date and time without any sufficient cause shall be fined Rs. 10/- or such as college may fix. Without medical examination, students will not be allowed to appear in University Examination.

INCENTIVE MARKS FOR NSS / GAMES & SPORTS / PEP / WSSC / CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

Students participating in NSS / Games & Sports / PEP / WSSC / Cultural Activities may be given up to 10 Marks by the University as per rules

SCHOLARSHIPS, FREESHIP AND CONCESSIONS

Various programmes are held throughout the academic year.

PARENT'S VISIT

Parents are requested to visit the College and meet the Principal / Lecturers twice a year.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

S. S. Girls' College having a well furnished and well equipped library. Total collection of library is 32,086 books on various subjects. It includes text books as per syllabus, reference books, competitive books, biographies; encyclopedias etc. Library subscribed 16 national/international journals, 14 periodicals, 39 national and local magazines and 25 newspapers.

Features of Library:

- 1. All the library operations are computerized with LIBMAN SOFTWARE by Master Software, Nagpur.
- 2. Internet facility through Broadband is available in library for students and faculty members.
- 3. E-journals and E-books can access through INFLIBNET Programme NLIST.
- 4. Library orientation programme and information literacy training programmes have been arranged for students.

The students have to observe the following instructions:

- The students are expected to keep the books issued to them in proper shape.
- ii) The books may Re. kept by students for not more than 07 days. A fine of Re. 1 per day for the delay will be imposed.

All Backwards class students and the students coming under the Lower Income Group should apply for Govt, of India scholarship in the prescribed form through their respective college after getting admission. The application form will be available to them at the time of their admission. All the students should be vigilant enough to fill in the form complete in all respects as any omission or incorrect / false information may disqualify them for the above SCH. The students having gap in their education should invariably file a court affidavit declaring as to what they were doing in the intervening period.

The students who were in receipt of Govt, of India scholarship last year and have passed the annual examination are required to fill no application forms. Their cases will be submitted to the Director of Social Welfare by the college for renewal of scholarship. The student of B. A. Part -1, B. Sc. (Home Science) Part-I will be treated as FRESH CANDIDATES for purpose of scholarship and as such they are required to apply for scholarship in the prescribed form.

E. B. C. CONCESSION:

- A) i) The students whose parents or guardians (if parents are not alive) annual income of the previous year is less than ₹1,00,000/- are entitled for these concessions. ii) Repeaters (those who fail in the University Exam, and study in the same class) are not entitled to E. B. C. iii) E. B. C. will not granted on Basic Pay only to the Private and Central Govt. Employee's Wards. iv) Students who have once taken their post graduate degree are not entitled to E. B. C. If they get themselves admitted either for another post graduate degree or law. v) The students should take note of the fact that if their parents/ guardians are Private/Central Government Employees, their entitlement of concession depends upon the total salary i.e. basic as well as other allowance that is to say the total salary be less than ₹1,00,000/-
- B) Students whose ordinary place of residence is within the state of Maharashtra only are entitled to free studentship. Students belonging to other states are not eligible for the grant of studentship.
- C) A student who has failed in one class in a faculty and changed the c. study and joined another faculty cannot be granted E. B. C. concession as repeats the same standard.
- D) Application form for free-studentship should be submitted either alongwith the application form or

RULES FOR AWARD OF FREE STUDENTSHIP TO SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF PRIMARY / SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS

Children of all full time primary school teachers working in:

- Government
- ii) Local Bodies School and
- iii) Recognized and Private Primary School are eligible for concession of free studentship.

- within 30 days from the date of beginning of current session.
- E) Every application for E. B. C. concession must be accompanied with Income Certificate of the previous year's income irrespective of the rural or urban to which the student belongs. The Income Certificate must be signed by of the following persons especially:
 - 1) Gazetted Officer of any department.
 - 2) Revenue non-ministerial officer not below class III status. Income Certificate signed by persons other than those mentioned above shall not be accepted.
 - 3) Application form must be submitted with Income Certificate in duplicate.
- F) A student is entitled to enjoy the educational concession under one scheme only at a time.
- G) A student enjoying E. B. C. concession must fulfill at least 75% of the attendance and must behave in a disciplined way failing which her free studentship shall be discontinued and permission to appear at the Examination may not be granted to her.
- H) In case the applicant's parent or guardian is illiterate, she should put her / his left hand thumb impression with the following words below left hand thumb impression of (Name of Parent).

Note: Students will not be informed separately regarding E. B. C., G. O. I. and other forms submission.

CONDITION OF ELIGIBILITY

- a) Free studentship shall be subject to regular attendance (not less then 75%) satisfactory progress and good conduct.
- b) Free studentship shall be awarded only to those pupils whose parents are residents of Maharashtra State.
- c) Application shall be made within a period of 30 days from date of the opening of the Educational Institution in the case of pupil who has been already admitted and within a period of 30 days from the date of admission in the case of pupil, newly admitted.


