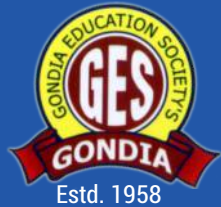

■ PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND RECREATION

1. Abstract from ordinance No. 9 : Under this ordinance of the University, all the undergraduate students of College shall be required to participate in Physical Training.
2. a) All undergraduate students in the college affiliated to Nagpur University who opt for Physical Training shall attend Physical Education Classes, 3 periods in a week with a minimum of 60 periods in a session. Failure to attend the classes will be fined at the rate of Rs. 1/- per class.
b) Each Physical Training period will be of 30 minutes duration for Physical Exercises and recreation activities.
c) The Board of Physical Education and Recreation may prescribe uniforms.
3. The students must attend at least 80% of the Physical Training Periods actually held in a session.
4. The following classes of students shall be exempted from the operation of this ordinance.
 - i) Students having completed the age of 26 at the time of admission to the college.
 - ii) Students found unfit on medical ground if recommended by the Medical Officer of the college and Principal with detailed reasons for unfitness,
 - iii) Student in the final year.
 - iv) Students who have participated in : a) Inter Collegiate, b) Inter University or c) State Level Tournaments.
 - v) Students attending Social Service Camp arranged or approved by the college.
 - vi) Students who have attended college gymnastics and outdoor sports.
5. A Students who is eligible for examination under clause 4 above shall obtain an Exemption Certificate in the prescribed form from the Principal before 1st December every year and shall attached the same to her application for admission to the examination. NO case of exemption shall be considered unless Exemption Certificate is attached by the student to her application form for admission to the examination.
6. If a student fails to present herself at the Physical Efficiency Test without sufficient cause, she shall pay a fine of Rs.10/- or more as decided by the college.

■ PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF FORM OR G.O.I. SCHOLARSHIP:

All Backwards class students and the students coming under the Lower Income Group should apply for Govt. of India scholarship in the prescribed form through their respective college after getting admission. The application form will be available to them at the time of their admission. All the students should be vigilant enough to fill in the form complete in all respects as any omission or incorrect false information may disqualify them for the above Scholarship. The students having gap in their education should invariably file a court affidavit declaring as to what they were doing in the intervening period.

The students who were in receipt of Govt. of India scholarship last year and have passed the annual examination are required to fill no application forms. Their cases will be submitted to the Director of Social welfare by the college for renewal of scholarship. The student of B.A. Part-1, B.Sc. (Home Science) Part-I will be treated as FRESH CANDIDATES for purpose of scholarship and as such they are required to apply for scholarship in the prescribed form.
